## The Big Walk for Dyslexia

Date: Sunday 12 May 2024

Time: Start time will be allocated between 10.30am and 11.00am.

Start/Finish: Helen Arkell Dyslexia Charity, 24 West Street, Farnham, Surrey. GU9 7DR.

Purpose: To raise funds for the Helen Arkell Dyslexia Charity

**Distance:** The walk is approximately 5K (3.1miles) with the option of a shorter 3.7k (2.35 miles) walk or a longer 2 laps of the park walk 8.8km (5.5 miles).

Car Parking: Car parking is available in the town public car parks.

**Route:** You will receive detailed instructions for the route including the location of toilets and refreshments. You may wish to bring a picnic as facilities are limited. The route includes some unmade paths, and you will need to wear appropriate footwear. There may be mud in parts depending on the weather. The route crosses the road at several points. **Please take extra care when crossing the road**.

There are some uneven sections as well as short hilly sections. There are one or two gates/ stiles to be crossed, which would make the route difficult for wheelchair-users or people of limited mobility.

Anyone taking part with a condition requiring the avoidance of strenuous activity should check with their doctor that this event is not considered a risk.

**Weather:** In the event of inclement weather –cold, wet or hot – please ensure that all walkers have adequate footwear, clothing and drinks with them for the conditions.

**Young people:** Those under 18 must be accompanied by an adult, who will be registered as in-charge.

**Contact mobile number:** please complete this section of the booking form which is required for safety reasons.

**Cost:** £5 per person registration fee to cover administration cost. Children 12 and under free.

**Sponsorship:** Suggested minimum sponsorship of £20 per adult, optional for children. There will be a prize for the highest sponsorship achieved by a child (under 18).

**Registration:** It is essential to register in advance to enable Helen Arkell to account for those participating.

**Cancellation:** If for some unforeseen reason the walk is cancelled, we will notify all registered walkers by email and post details on our website and social media. Please note that registration fees will not be refunded. We will endeavour to reschedule the event.
